

NAPERVILLE MEMORIAL DAY PARADE EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

In the event of a threatening situation (i.e. Violent Weather, National Emergency, Civil unrest or any other similar situation) requiring shelter, the following procedures will be executed. These procedures apply before the parade, during staging and while the parade is in progress.

Before the parade, members of the Naperville Police Department, Naperville Fire Department and Naperville Emergency Management Agency will be responsible for directing participants to shelter.

The above listed agencies will direct participants in the staging areas to take shelter at one of the following buildings:

1. Band members lined up near the VFW will move to Church of the Brethren (Jefferson & Parkside) for shelter. Buses will be staged in that area and will begin pickup from the church as soon as safety allows.
2. Scout and other youth organizations will be moved to the second floor of the VFW and be sheltered there.
3. Adult groups in the beach parking lot will be moved to the lower level of the VFW and the Grand Pavilion if needed.

During the parade:

1. All units that have not yet stepped off will be directed to Judd Kendall VFW Post 3873 or to Little Shepherd School.
2. Units located on Jackson Ave., between Ewing St. and Main St. will be directed to City Hall (400 S. Eagle St.)
3. Units located on Jackson Ave. between Main St. and Washington St and on Washington St. between Jackson and Jefferson will be directed to the City Parking Garage on Chicago Ave. just East of Washington.
4. Units located on Washington St. between Jefferson and Benton and on Benton between Washington and Court Place will be directed to the City Parking Garage located just West of Washington St. between Van Buren and Benton.
5. Any units on Court Place can seek shelter in Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church or the Community Concert Center.

Although we realize that this Emergency Plan does not address every possible situation and in fact is geared towards weather emergencies, we sincerely hope that these precautions will provide parade participants reasonable shelter until such time as the situation subsides.
